Hunter, Equitation, Jumpers, Western/English

Outdoor Arena: (Bad weather, held in indoor arena)

Open schooling 8:00 to 8:50am

First class at 9:00AM Sharp!

Pleasure: Western or English Adults only

1. Walk, Trot

2. Walk, Trot, Canter

3. Walk, Trot, Canter, Rein Back, Obstacles (may include poles, barrels, small cross rails)

Lead Line: Open to riders under age 9.

4. Walk

5. Walk/some trot/poles optional

Beginner Equitation Division: Western or English. Judge on hands, seat, and mount control. Adults may ride ponies.

- 5 Beginner Equitation walk/trot
6. Beginner Equitation walk/trot/canter
7. Beginner Equitation cross rails/ground poles

17 and under Equitation: Judged on equitation, may be asked questions by judge. English or western!

8. 12 & under Equitation walk/trot
9. 12 & under Equitation w/t/c
10. 12 & under Equitation o/f up to 12" (English), Over poles (Western)

Adult (18 and up) Equitation: Judged on equitation, may be asked questions by judge. English or western!

11. Equitation walk/trot

13. Equitation o/f up to 12" (English), Equitation over poles (Western)

Open Equitation: Judged on equitation and control of mounts. Open to all ages and levels of riders.

14. Open Equitation walk/trot/canter

16. Open Equitation course 2', 2'3", or 2'6"

Not to begin before 10:30AM:

Hopeful Hunter: Open to green horses (and riders). 40% rider

17. Hopeful Hunter under saddle

19. Hopeful Hunter course 18" or 2'

Modified Hunter: Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. 40% rider.

20. Modified Hunter under saddle
21. Modified Hunter course 2' or 2'3"

Schooling Hunter: Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. 40% rider.

23. Schooling Hunter under saddle

Not to begin before 12:00noon:

Grasshopper Jumpers: fences 12" or 18"

Gymkhana/Games:

Indoor Arena: (If bad weather, the following classes will be held after the final jumper class, please call if weather is questionable to find out when these classes will be held)

Open schooling: 8:00 to 9:50 AM, First Class at 10 AM Sharp!

"Dollar" Bareback: may use bareback pads, saddle pads, or nothing.

- 40. W/T/C and obstacles

Egg and Spoon (Maybe split into age groups)

- 41. Walk and Trot
- 42. Walk, Trot, Canter

Flag Race (Maybe split into age groups)

Chase Me Charlie

44. Everyone begins with a vertical jump at 2'3", after everyone goes- fence goes up one hole (~3" inches), continues until only one horse is left. Horse/pony pulls a rail they are out. (Think of the limbo game only- over not under!)

Scramble: Includes bending 3 poles, one jump, around a barrel! (Maybe split into age groups)

- 45. Scramble

Hour glass: use of barrels game (Maybe split into age groups)

- 46. Hour Glass pattern

4-leaf Clover: barrel pattern (Maybe split into age groups)

- 45. Four leaf pattern

Big "T" (Maybe split into age groups)

- 47. "T" pattern, with barrels and poles

All classes:

Fees: Classes 1 through 37 \$8.50 each

Classes 38 through 47 \$5.00 each

- Blank checks may be left with entry. Settle up on total due at the end of your classes, any unsettled rider/horse checks will have a \$20 office fee added to the total of entry fee(s).

- Adults may ride ponies.
- All returned checks will be charged a \$45.00 additional fee, added to the total of you entry fees.
- **Schooling attire welcomed! Must have approved helmet and footwear on at all times when mounted!**
- Please NO DOGS. - No grounds or schooling fees. - Water on site, please bring your own buckets.

Class and Show Rules

**** Classes where the courses have a choice of height:** Rider may enter the same class number one time for each height if desired, with the same horse and rider combination. Preferred height of choice must be declared at time of entry to the class.

**** Classes AND divisions may be cancelled, split AND/OR combined based on number of entries as needed, at the discretion of show secretary, organizer, or judge!** In this case points will count towards the class as the rider had entered, or if that division is not run at two or more shows throughout the series than the points will count in the division/class that placing was awarded.

*****JUMPERS--** May walk course before each class.

Time jump off: ride course, if you jump with no rails down, stay in ring and complete jump off course.

Power & Speed: Jump the first half of the course, if all rails stay up, complete the second half of the course. The second half will be timed. First half may be timed to determine placement if there is a tie.

Gamblers' Choice: Each fence in the arena will have a point value assigned to it, riders' make up their own course over any fence in the arena, each fence may be jumped no more than twice each. Jumping a fence more than twice each will result in deduction of that fences' point value for each time the fence was jumped after the two time limit had been reached. Goal to win class is= the most points in the fastest time! Time limit 40 seconds.

Hunter, Equitation, Lead Line, Jumper, Western/English Rules

◆ Ribbons: 1st through 6th per class each show. Champion and Reserve Champion per division at each show.

◆ DOUBLE points dates: June 6th and September 19th

◆ Points: Awarded per class with 6 or more horse/rider combinations 1st 6 points, 2nd 5 points, 3rd 4 points, 4th 3 points, 5th 2 points, 6th 1 point, 7th .5 point, 8th .25 points. Awarded per class with 5 or fewer horse/rider combinations 1st 4 points, 2nd 3 points, 3rd 2 points, 4th 1 point, 5th .5 point. All Division Champion 2 extra points. Reserve Champion 1 extra point. Each rider will be 'given' 1 extra point for each complete division he/she competes per show date.

Series Award Information

■ Series End Division Champion and Reserve Division Champion: based on points earned throughout the series.

^ Points based on Rider earned only: Classes 1 to 16

^ Points based on Horse earned only: Classes 17 to 25

^ Points based on Horse and Rider combination only: Classes 26 to 37

- Division must have been held at all 4 of the 6 shows.

- Will be awarded at the final show!

■ Series End Horse/Pony Award: This is for the horse or pony (privately owned, school horse,

leased, or what case may be) who has carried his/her rider(s) to the most points for the series! Each horse will be followed throughout the series, points will be counted from all classes the horse(s) compete in.

- Horse or Pony must be present and ridden in 4 of 6 shows to qualify.
- Award: TBA, will be given to the OWNER of the horse/pony at the end of the final show. Rider(s) will also be recognized.

▣ **Series End Rider Award:** This is for the rider who has guided their horses and ponies to the most points for the series! Each rider will be followed throughout the series, points will be counted from all classes the rider competes in.

- Rider must be ride in 4 of the 6 shows to qualify.
- Award: TBA, given at the end of the final show.

▣ **Series End Trainer Award:** Here is to the trainers and instructors who take the time to share their knowledge! To qualify please follow these guidelines...

1. Sign in with the secretary when you arrive at each show. Letting us know to which of your students/horses, "students", are riding that day.
 2. When you sign up be ready to list you students and horses who are entered. Points will only count per horse/rider combinations. You may add horses, riders, and switch horse/rider combinations at each show as needed.
 3. It is your responsibility to keep your "student" list up to date with us. All changes to that list must be made before you first student or horse competes on each show day to count.
 4. Must attend and have student(s) riding in at least 4 of the 6 shows to have points count.
 5. Points calculated as follows: based on your "students" placing 1st -2.5pts., 2nd -2pts., 3rd -1.5 pt, 4th -1 pt., 5th -.5 pt, 6th -.25 pt, division Champion- 3 pts, division Res. Champion-1.5 pts.
- Award: TBA, given at the end of the final show!

***Please Note: If award winner is not present on final show day: A) WWEC will contact winner within 3 days of show. B) Winner has 10 days to make arrangements to pick up or have prize shipped to them. C) After that time frame award is void.*

Gymkhana/Games Rules:

- ◆ Ribbons 1st thru 3rd each class
- ◆ If warranted, each class may be divided in any combination of the following groups based on age or level. To be spilt there must be a minimum of 7 entries per class.
 - 10 and under - 11 to 17 - 18 and up
 - 18 and up Novice - 18 and up Open
- ◆ Series Champion and Reserve Champion
 - For each class.
 - Each class must have been completed at 4 out of 6 shows.
 - There must be 3 or more riders qualified for Series Champion and Reserve Champion for class to be awarded a Champion and Reserve Champion. Prize and ribbon.

***Please Note: If award winner is not present on final show day: A) WWEC will contact winner within 3 days of show. B) Winner has 10 days to make arrangements to pick up or have prize shipped to them. C) After that time frame award is void.*
