Would you like to build more confidence in both your horse and self as a rider or handler?

Have a green young horse, need any ideas on ‘bomb proofing’?

Then you may want to join us October 4, 2009 at 10am!! Rick Pelicano is teaching a three hour clinic unlike any other to horses, riders, owners, handlers, and other interested parties. Rick has over 20 years of experience as a mounted patrol officer in Maryland and training police horses and riders. If there is a use for horses which requires complete trust and unnerving stability, it is the patrol horse. Rick is also certified through the American Riding Instructor Certification Program, Level III Mounted Patrol Training Officer, and was in the mounted security detail at the 1996 Olympic Games that were held in Georgia.

Horses, riders, and handlers from all disciplines and levels are encouraged to come and take part in this clinic!! The clinic will start at 10AM. Everyone will begin unmounted in a large group, with Rick and up to two assistants (who work with Rick year round) starting off explaining what you will be seeing and doing. It will be left to rider choice if he/she wishes to ride through some obstacles, or rider/handler may choose to work only from the ground with their mounts. This program is flexible but intense, teaching behavior management techniques and utilizing the "comfort zone" method, certified instructor Rick Pelicano successfully trains horse and rider through obstacle courses, smoke, gunfire, sirens, flags, and other mechanisms

!!Space is limited to 25 horses/rider/handler combinations!!

Cost is \$235 per horse/rider/handler combination, includes ONE auditor admittance.

Non-refundable deposit of \$100 may be sent now to hold your spot, with \$135 due by Sept. 25.

Auditors are welcomed, \$40.00 per person (ONLY exception is as included in horse entry fee)
